2007 Angier Christmas Parade
Rules/General Information**

KEEP A COPY FOR YOUR REFERENCE

- **All** applications must be approved by the Parade Committee
- No items, **including candy**, will be allowed to be thrown onto the streets or to the spectators by parade participants during the parade. **This will be enforced.** Walking entries may hand out candy as long as safety is not compromised.
- All entries including floats, bands, marchers and groups, are responsible for transportation to and from the parade line up and the parade break down.
- Entry must have a Christmas theme and be appropriately decorated – **No Santa.** Only Christmas music is allowed to be played by entries. No entries are allowed to display rude, vulgar, obscene markings or music.
- High Performance racing cars will be allowed to enter, however, **these cars shall not rev or race their engines while in the parade. Jack Rabbit starts and sudden stops will not be allowed.** Any vehicle displayed on a trailer or any other device shall not have the engine running. Any driver operating any vehicle in a careless manner will be charged accordingly.

- **You will receive your line-up assignment in the mail prior to the parade.**
- Pick-up points for walking and marching entries will be located at the Angier Black River Fire Department. All other entries will be required to “break-down” and/or be picked up at Trinity Baptist Church – Wray and Broad Streets. This will ensure easy departure by all participants.
The parade will end at the intersection of Broad Street and Wimberly Road.
- **All horses** will be at the end of the parade. **Horses will meet on the corner of Broad and McIver Street in the grass area.**
- All persons riding on floats, in vehicles or on horses, marching in bands or any other group participation in the parade must be 18 years of age or have parental approval. Said parental approval shall contain a disclaimer relieving the Angier Chamber of Commerce and the Town of Angier of any and all responsibility in case of accident that does or does not result in an injury, stolen or damaged property, and for any other claim against the Angier Chamber of Commerce or the Town of Angier as a result of participating in the Christmas Parade.
